### Does Pre-Aging work on any wood species?

Pre-Aging will work on virtually any wood species with the exception of some coniferous wood species (like Pine or Fir) where white flecks may present themselves after the Pre-Aging has dried. So, ...

### Is Pre-Aging a reactive stain?

No, Pre-Aging is not a chemically reactive stain. It mimics the appearance of reactive stains without their drawbacks, such as tannin dependency, limited species compatibility, unpredictable col...

### Can I mix colors of Pre-Aging?

Yes, you can mix colors of Pre-Aging before applying.

### Can I dilute Pre-Aging?

No, we do not recommended diluting Pre-Aging. It is better to either select a lighter color or to intermix Pre-Aging colors.

### Do I need to put finish over Pre-Aging?

Yes, Pre-Aging does not protect or seal the wood. After applying Pre-Aging, it is necessary to apply Oil Plus 2C to protect and seal the wood surface.

### Does Pre-Aging raise the wood grain?

Yes, Pre-Aging will raise the wood fibers. Use a maroon pad to knock down the raised grain after Pre-Aging dries.

### Does Pre-Aging work on veneer?

Yes, Pre-Aging works on veneered wood.

### Can I use any finish over Pre-Aging?

Pre-Aging is designed to be used in conjunction with Oil Plus 2C. However, you may apply another manufacturer's finish over Pre-Aging, but it's important to first test it on a sample to ensure there...

### Can I mix Pre-Aging with Precolor Easy?

No, we do not recommend mixing Pre-Aging with Precolor Easy. They are not designed to be used together.
