Can I do a spot treatment with Renew or do I need to apply it over the full surface?

You can do spot treatments on the wood surface with Renew. It is not required to treat the full surface. It will blend together as it dries.

Can I use Renew over any color of Oil Plus 2C?

Yes, you can use Renew over any color of Oil Plus 2C.

What is the difference between Renew and Universal Maintenance Oil?

Renew will blend in with the original matte sheen of Oil Plus 2C which allows you to do spot treatments if necessary. Universal Maintenance Oil increases the sheen from matte to a velvet sheen...

Can I use Renew over Universal Maintenance Oil or SheenPlus?

Once you choose either Universal Maintenance Oil or SheenPlus, it is recommended to continue to maintain the surface with that same product down the road.

Is Renew 0% VOC?

Renew contains a solvent that is defined by the EPA as VOC exempt.
